

# SALMON PRO

## PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Salmon Pro is a hydrolysed fish protein produced in a FEMAS certified factory from the viscera of farmed Atlantic Salmon (*Salmo salar*) reared in sea lochs and open water under strict welfare conditions. All raw materials are by-products of human consumption processing and conform to the MarinTrust standard for responsible sourcing. The salmon content is 95% or greater.
